Please do not label these items.

- 2- Plastic storage bins with lids for extra items in cubbies, [ideally this size: 11x14x6](#), but no smaller than shoebox size
- 1 - Pack Expo Markers (thick or thin, any color)
- 1 - Package sidewalk chalk
- 1 - Package pony beads (any color)
- 1 - Package watercolor paper

Boys

- 1 - Container of disinfectant wipes
- 1 - Snack-size paper plates (compostable preferred)
- 1 - Box of facial tissues

Girls

- 1 - Pack page protectors for 3-ring binders
- 1 - Roll of paper towels
- 1 - Package of baby wipes

Please label these items.

- 1 - 1 in. White vinyl binder with clear overlay on cover and spine
- 1 - 2 Full sets of extra change of clothes (socks, underwear, shorts/pants, shirts)
- 1 - Child-size reusable water bottle
- 1 - Backpack **big enough** for a lunchbox, library book, and water bottle (about 12" x 6" x 15")

ALL DAY STUDENTS:

Rest time supplies: 1 small blanket, 1 small pillow, 1 small stuffed animal, and 1 large crib-sized sheet to cover the cot

Your child will need to bring the following items:

- At least two, season-appropriate changes of clothes (underwear, socks, pants, shirt)
- Sunhat or baseball cap
- Sturdy rain boots and waterproof warm winter boots (*Insulated* rain boots like [BOGS](#) or similar will work for all seasons)

- One piece, **waterproof** snowsuits are the preferred gear for winter months, but snow bibs and a good winter jacket will also work.
- Warm hat for cold days
- Light mittens for fall days
- Sunscreen and bug spray

- Rain bibs
- Waterproof rain mittens
- Waterproof winter mittens
