Please do not label these items:

- ☐ 1 - 9x12 Mixed Media Paper Pad

Please label these items:

- ☐ 1 - 1 in. White Vinyl Binder with Clear Overlay on Cover and Spine
- ☐ 1 - *Child-Size* Reusable Water Bottle (filled each day and easy to open/sip)
- ☐ 1 - Backpack
- ☐ 1 - Lunch Box with Ice Pack (if packing cold lunches/snacks) - bento-style boxes that the child can open work best
- ☐ 2 - changes of weather-appropriate clothing (tops, bottoms, socks; if potty-learning please supply extra underwear)
- ☐ Diapers, wipes, & diaper cream (teachers will notify when more diapering supplies are needed)
- ☐ Weather-appropriate outdoor gear (rain boots, raincoat & pants or rain bibs (prefer bibs to one-piece so we can wear on warmer yet muddy days), sun hat or ball cap, extra sweater or light jacket) to be kept at school. When the winter weather approaches, please have the following ready: snowsuit or snowpants and jacket (snowsuit is easiest for independent dressing), mittens (NO gloves), warm boots, warm hat. - ☐ Please also send your child with soft-soled, velcro or slip-on shoes to be worn throughout the day. The goal is that your child is capable of getting these on and off with little or no help (we are fostering independence and love your help:)
