

ULS Activity Fee

The ULS Commitment to enhance programs and experiences to enrich student life and strengthen our community is the driving force behind the ULS Activity Fee (previously called Parent Organization Activity Fee). This fee is meant to provide enhancements to the life of our community outside of the Instructional day. The fees will be increased to better align with the full scope of activities that make ULS special in 2026 and beyond.

Goals

- Support student enrichment activities
- Develop a sense of community for students and parents alike
- Provide opportunities to exemplify character through service
- Foster school spirit, while supporting the goals of each activity

2026-2027 Activity Fee:

- Lower School: **\$245**
- Middle & Upper School: **\$295**
- Second & third student: **50% off**, with a **\$590 family maximum**

Additional grade level fees

- Eighth Grade Leadership Fee: \$425
- Junior Test Prep Fee: \$125

In addition to the activity fees, there are key elements of the 8th grade and 11th grade leadership experience that come with rising costs to maintain. These adjustments ensure we can continue providing meaningful, high-quality experiences for our students.

Families can request scholarship assistance for the grade-specific fees during eighth and eleventh grade years. This scholarship is available on a limited basis to cover between 20% - 50% of eighth grade and/or eleventh grade fees based upon need.'

Graduation Fee

Seniors who graduate from ULS receive a graduation experience that models their experience at ULS - highly personalized and incredibly rich. The graduation fee for 12th grade is not new, but it is increasing to \$425 for 2026-27 to cover the rising costs of Senior Dinner and Graduation.
